



Inside Out Learning at Coleham School Autumn 2020.

In the first half term the sessions are aimed to encourage children to play, learn and have fun outdoors. The sessions will include shelter building, ground art, simple woodwork and making campfires. There will also be plenty of opportunities for child-initiated play. The sessions will be run by a fully qualified teacher (Level 3 Forest School Leader) and a qualified teaching assistant. The second half of the term will be a mix of outside and inside sessions because of the dark evenings. These sessions will also include STEM activities like designing and building and investigating.

Year 2 Sessions: Mondays

1st term 21st Sept to 2 Nov, (includes the first week back after half term)-**6 weeks**

2nd Term 9 Nov to 14th Dec -**6 weeks**

Year 3 Sessions: Wednesdays

1st term 23rd Sept to 4th Nov, (includes the first week back after half term)-**6 weeks**

2nd Term 11th Nov to 16th Dec -**6 weeks**

Both take place in the conservation area /outdoor classroom please pick your child up at 4.30pm from the front of the school and we will meet you at the KS2 side gate.

Children will need wellies or old trainers, a shower proof/waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers. **(If you can't provide any of the above items please get in touch with me or the school office staff as we have lots of spare kit in lots of sizes).** The children often get quite dirty and we do go out in most weathers, except when it's very windy. Sometimes we have a hot drink like hot chocolate or hot blackcurrant and make things like toast, crumpets and popcorn on the fire, so please let me know of any allergies/intolerances.

Each session costs £5 x 6 weeks, total to pay is = £30

If you want to book the second half term too it will be a total of £60 for the term.
