## E-safety Resources

We hope that you are keeping well during this time.

Now that many children and parents are learning and working from home, E-safety has never been more important. As staff and parents ourselves, we know how difficult it is to keep up to date with new technologies and find trusted information about them. **We have, therefore, invested in an E-safety package with National Online Safety for all staff, children and parents to use.**

This is an excellent one- stop-shop for online safety, including:

- Parent course videos presented by Myleene Klass;
- Short explainer videos of key E-safety terms and introducing the 8 e-safety topics the children learn in school;
- Monthly Updates; and
- Over 250 poster guides on specific Apps, social media, computer games and devices. These guides have been put together by industry experts are simple to follow. (I've attached a Guide on Zoom as an example for you to look at.)

This new package will also help us to enhance our e-safety curriculum in school. There are 8 key topics outlined in the UKCCIS 'Education for a connected world' that the children will cover in their e-safety lessons each half term. Parents are welcome to browse the lesson resources, should you wish to see how e-safety is explained to different age groups.
